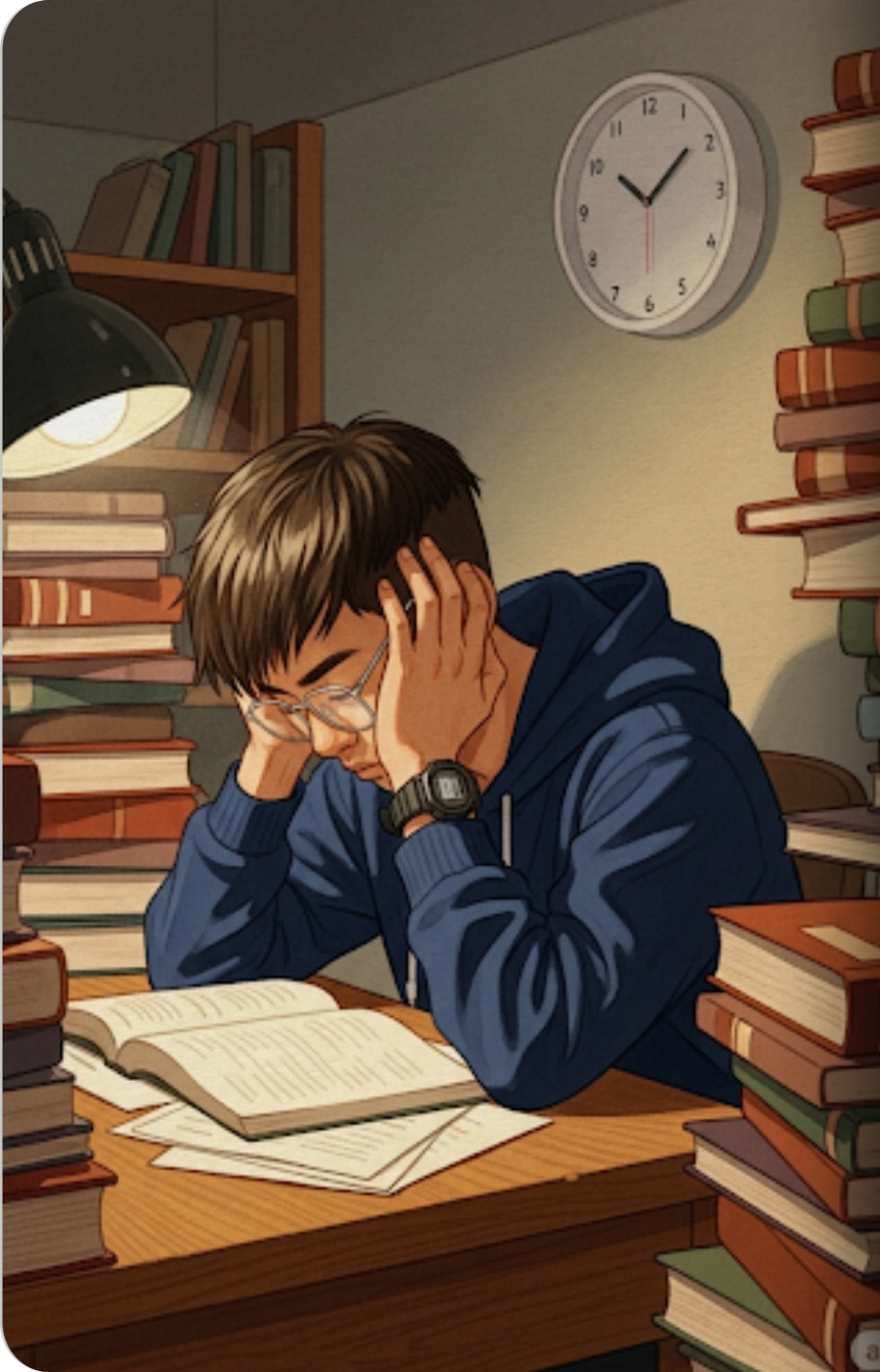




How Students Can Use AI to Learn Faster: Unlock Your Brain with ChatGPT & Gemini
